## MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 19 MAY 2016

### **2017 Public Question Time**

In the absence of the Chairman and Vice Chairman it was proposed and seconded that Cllr Williams chairs the meeting.

There were no members of the public in attendance.

### **2018 Apologies**

Apologies were received from Cllrs Buckley, Hannan, Hughes and Nixon.

### **2019 Declaration of Members' Interests**

The Chairman asked Councillors to make any declarations of interest prior to the relevant item being discussed.

### **2020 Approval of the Minutes of the Meetings Held on :-**

21 April 2016

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the meeting held on 21 April 2016 be approved.

### **2021 Matters Arising**

(2015) Reports (Anti-social behaviour faced by residents of Campbell Walk) - The Clerk reminded Councillors that two barriers were to be erected at either end of the 'black' path, one paid for by the Parish Council and one paid for by Barratt David Wilson Homes. These will deter motor bikes and quad bikes from using the path as a race track.

(2015) Reports (Resource Centre and section 106 money) - The Clerk informed Councillors that no response had yet been received from RMBC following the meeting to discuss the various options for housing the library as part of a 'Community Hub'. It was agreed to seek some feedback as soon as possible.

(2016) Correspondence (Councillor Vacancy) - It was agreed to hold a Special Ordinary Meeting on 26 May 2016 in order to co-opt a new Councillor.

### **2022 Community Issues**

- Police

There were no representatives of the Police in attendance.

- RMBC Ward Councillors

Cllr Roddison said that the newly elected RMBC Councillors for the Brinsworth & Catcliffe Ward were now known and that work to represent the whole community would begin in earnest.

Cllr Roddison informed Councillors that there had recently been an increase in the number of burglaries in Brinsworth and also a spate of car number plates being stolen.

- Others

Cllr Dyson expressed concern that the road repair on Bawtry Road where the bridge crosses the River Don had not lasted very long and needed further attention. Cllr Roddison agreed to follow up on this issue.

## **2023 YLCA**

- To approve Councillors having access to NALC Website

The Clerk informed Councillors that all member councils of YLCA can now log-in to the members section of the NALC website. In addition, providing it is agreed by the Parish Council, Councillors can also have access. If so, it must be noted that the log-in details should not be shared with members of the public or with other councils who are not members of YLCA.

RESOLVED: That Councillors should have access to the members section of the NALC website and should therefore be given the log-in details.

## **2024 Planning**

- To receive RMBC Planning Lists 16 - 19

a) RB2016/0464 - Detached double garage with ancillary living in roof space at Peartree Place off Brinsworth Road - noted

b) RB2016/0482 - Erection of 22 no. pitched roof garages and 9 no. pitched roof stores at land to rear of 3-5 Willowgarth Avenue - Councillors expressed concerns that small businesses could operate from a garage site. It was agreed to write to RMBC asking, if permission is granted, that a condition to be attached which prohibits any trading being conducted from them. In addition, the developer be asked to make a contribution of £1,500 towards the cost of the litter picker.

c) RB2016/0414 - Display of 1 no. illuminated sign at Brinsworth Academy - noted

d) RB2016/0505 - Display of 1 no. non-illuminated fascia sign at 206a Brinsworth Lane - noted

e) RB2016/0507 - Change of use of disused bakery to restaurant (use class A3) and single storey front extension at 206a Brinsworth Lane - Councillors expressed concerns about the possibility of extra noise with the site being opposite homes of older people. It was agreed to ask that conditions be applied which specify reasonable opening hours and that sufficient bins are made available to limit the amount of litter. In addition, the applicant be asked to make a contribution of £1,500 towards the cost of the litter picker.

f) RB2016/0547 - Single storey rear extension at 19 Howlett Drive - noted

RB2016/0301 - Demolition of existing building and erection of single storey toilets/rest room at Phoenix Sports & Social Club Pavilion Lane - granted conditionally

RB2016/0402 - Two storey side extension at 33 Crownhill Road - granted conditionally

RB2016/0360 - Porch to front at 3 Keswick Crescent - granted conditionally

## **2025 Reports**

The Clerk reported on a meeting with a Senior Engineer from RMBC, attended by Cllrs Buckley & Williams and himself, to discuss the possibility of opening the access between Wood Lane and Europa Way to all traffic. It was explained that the response from Brinsworth residents to this possibility had been significant, with most in favour of it being two ways but all in favour of at least one way. The Engineer understood the reasons and agreed to look at the options. However, in order to assist in assessing the impact of any action on neighbouring roads he said that extensive traffic modelling will need to be done. This will require the Sheffield Rotherham Transport Model being updated, a process which is likely to be completed by October 2016.

Cllr Gregory reported on her attendance at the RVWAA.

Cllr Dyson informed Councillors that arrangements were all in place for the exhibition 'Memories of Catcliffe' being held at the Mere Brow Centre on 4 June 2016.
